DEGREE COURSES

TUITION FEES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA ARE COMPOSED OF A FIXED FEE AND A VARIABLE FEE (CONTRIBUTION). THE VARIABLE FEE IS DETERMINED ON AN INDIVIDUAL BASIS ACCORDING TO EACH STUDENT'S ECONOMIC SITUATION.

INCOMES PRODUCED ABROAD

STUDENTS WITH INCOMES PARTIALLY OR ENTIRELY PRODUCED ABROAD CANNOT PROCEED ONLINE AND MUST PRESENT THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS DIRECTLY TO THE TAX OFFICE DURING OPENING HOURS (VIA FERRATA 5, PAVIA) AND WITHIN NOVEMBER 21:

- ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES OF INCOMES OF ALL FAMILY MEMBERS
- CERTIFICATE OF FAMILY COMPOSITION, ALSO INDICATING ANY MEMBER WITH STRONG DISABILITY
- CERTIFICATE OF PROPERTY HOUSES WITH SQUARE METERS
- CERTIFICATE PROVING CAPITAL AND RESERVES OF THE FAMILY

ALL THESE DOCUMENTS MUST BE REFERRED TO THE YEAR 2015 (JAN-DEC), TRANSLATED INTO ITALIAN AND LEGALIZED BY THE ITALIAN EMBASSY OR CONSULATE WHERE THE INCOMES ARE PRODUCED. IN CASE THESE CERTIFICATES DO NOT COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

STUDENTS APPLYING TO EDISU (ENTE REGIONALE PER IL DIRITTO ALLO STUDIO) FOR BENEFITS RELATED TO THE RIGHT TO STUDY (E.G. SCHOLARSHIPS, ASSIGNMENT OF A PLACE IN UNIVERSITY COLLEGES, CANTEEN SERVICE, etc.) DO NOT HAVE TO FILL IN MOD.216 OR PRESENT FOREIGN INCOMES TO THE TAX OFFICE, THEY ONLY HAVE TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF EDISU, ACCORDING TO THEIR TERMS AND CONDITIONS (<http://www.edisu.pv.it>). EDISU WILL TRANSMIT THESE DATA TO THE UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA, IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO SUBMIT THE DATA TWICE, THE UNIVERSITY TAX WILL BE WORKED OUT AUTOMATICALLY.

First instalment (composition)

Students who enrol in a 1st year degree course pay a fixed amount of € 680.00 (fixed fee + € 181,73 advance payment of the yearly variable tuition fee). The deadline to pay the 1st instalment corresponds to the enrolment deadline. The rest of the tuition fee has to be paid with the 2nd instalment (see below). If the amount of € 181,73 exceeds the due annual variable fee, the student will be reimbursed by July 2017.

Students who enrol in subsequent years of study will pay a first instalment made up of the fixed fee (€ 498,27) and 50% of the tuition fees paid in the academic year 2015/2016. All students enrolled in the following year have to pay the 1st instalment by **17 October 2016**.

Second instalment (composition)

The second instalment is the difference between the fees for the whole academic year (fixed taxation of €498,27 and variable contribution) and the amount paid in the 1st instalment. The outstanding balance must be paid by **31 mar. 2017**.

CONVERSION OF UNIVERSITY DIPLOMAS (DU) INTO DEGREES

Students interested in the conversion of their DU (obtained on the basis of outdated didactic Regulation such as per item no.3, paragraph 1 of the D.M. 509/99 and further modifications and integrations) must pay, besides the fixed instalment, an amount of tuition fees varying according to percentages listed in the below table. The same rule is applicable also to owners of certification of Schools Specialising in Professional Purposes who wish to achieve the same conversion.

INDEPENDENT STUDENTS

The student's family status will be integrated with that of their parents, except in the following cases:

1 – There is evidence that the student has lived in a different house for at least 2 years (Form 216) and that the house s/he lives in does not belong to a member of the original family;

2 - Tax declarations that prove that the student has earned more than € 6.500,00 in the previous 2 years, and that s/he has not worked for a family member. This amount may be subject to change following the issuance of the decision of the Regional Government of Lombardy. This decision may modify the economic requirements necessary for the calculation of the indicators required to access the economic benefits.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Students from "low income countries" (Ministerial Decree 16 September 2015 n. 689) with a valid Italian Student Visa only pay the first instalment fixed fee of € 498,27.

EXEMPTIONS AND REIMBURSEMENTS

Please note that the University will refund, when due, only by bank transfer only to a bank account entitled to the student. Each student has to insert the IBAN bank code in the student reserved area of the bank account where the reimbursement will be made. Reimbursements will be processed within July 2017.

Regional tax exemptions or reimbursements:

1. Students with physical disabilities $\geq 66\%$
2. International students who receive grants from the Italian Government under the Development Cooperation Scheme and inter-government cultural and scientific agreements
3. Students who qualify for but do not receive the regional grants distributed by EDISU

Insurance exemptions or reimbursements:

1. Students with physical disabilities $\geq 66\%$
2. International students who receive grants from the Italian Government under the Development Cooperation Scheme and inter-government cultural and scientific agreements.
3. Students with an ISEE \leq €12,000.00

Student services fee exemptions or reimbursements

- 1) Students who qualify for and receive the regional grants doled out by EDISU
- 2) Employees of the University of Pavia with a permanent contract

Registration fee and tuition fee exemptions and reimbursements:

1. Students with physical disabilities $\geq 66\%$
2. International students who receive grants from the Italian Government under the Development Cooperation Scheme and inter-government cultural and scientific agreements.
3. Students who qualify for and receive regional grants from the EDISU

Contribution to the Cooperation and Knowledge Fund exemptions and reimbursements:

1. Students with physical disabilities $\geq 66\%$

Tuition Fee exemptions and reimbursements:

1. Students who enrol for the first time in an Italian university in a first-cycle degree course or a single-cycle laurea magistralis course and have completed high school with the highest possible score, 100/100. The same rule applies to international students that hold an equivalent qualification and the declaration of value on the school leaving certificate indicates the maximum score that can be earned.
2. The graduates who finish their second-cycle/laurea magistralis course within due time will be reimbursed 100% of the variable fee of the last year studies of the second cycle/laurea magistralis, if the enrolment years are no more than 3 for the first-cycle degree, and not more than two for the second-cycle degree. There will be no fee exemption if:
 - a. the course of studies has been interrupted between graduation in the first-cycle degree course and enrolment to the second-cycle/laurea magistralis degree course
 - b. If the student has obtained an abbreviation of the years of study (the student is enrolled not in the first year but in one of the subsequent years of study)
 - c. If the student has already been awarded such an exemption (for example if the student is enrolled in a second degree course at second-cycle/laurea magistralis level);
3. **Students with an ISEE $\leq 12,000.00$.**
4. Students who graduate by the regular completion time at second-cycle/laurea magistralis level will receive a 100% reimbursement of their final year variable fees, on condition that they present a number of enrolment years equal to the legal duration of their course of study.
5. Chinese students who enrol in the Italian-Chinese program of the laurea magistralis course in Architectural Engineering.
6. Students from "low income Countries" with a valid Italian Student Visa
7. Students who enrol in one of the following laurea magistralis held entirely in English pay 70% of the variable fees. Valid only for the first year of studies.
 - a. LM Computer Engineering
 - b. LM Electronic Engineering
 - c. LM Economics, finance and international integration
 - d. LM World politics and international relations
 - e. LM Industrial Automation Engineering
8. Students who obtained total equivalence of their academic title achieved abroad are exempted in the measure of 50% only of the part of university contributions.
9. According to the specific indications contained in the resolution of the Board of Administration on 25/10/2011, employees of the University of Pavia with a permanent contract are exempted by the payment of the contributions. This benefit can be requested by the employee for no more than five academic years for each bachelor and for a maximum of seven years including the master's degree course or single cycle courses. In any case, the enrollment will have to be of interest for the university and coherent with a growth project in relation to the job. The reimbursement is allocated for the first year of study after gaining 30 credits, then the student is exempted if he gains 30 credits for the following years
10. With resolution 264/2011 on 25/11/2011, a benefit was introduced for Technical Administrative personnel with children enrolled at the University of Pavia that consists in the exemption of 50% only of the part of the contributions. To be eligible for this benefit, these conditions must be met: the student must be a child of an employee in service at the University of Pavia with a permanent contract; the student must be present on the family members certificate and submit an ISEE declaration equal or lower than € 25.000; the student must gain at least 30 credits within 15 October 2016 referred to the year of enrollment. In case the student is in the first year, it is necessary to obtain 30 credits within 15/10/2017. A verification will be carried out at the end of October, in case the credits requirements will not be met, the benefit will be cancelled. It's the student's responsibility to verify the number of credits registered and displayed in the Reserved Area.

REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS IN PART-TIME SYSTEM

At the University of Pavia, students in particular conditions (job, disability, etc) are allowed to enrol in part time system. The disposals on this subject are contained in a specific Regulation that can be applied to first year students enrolling in 2016/17 and for students enrolled since 2013/14 on. Further information are available in the Secretary Students Office.

RULES FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF TAXES AND/OR CONTRIBUTIONS

Any reimbursement of taxes and contributions is allowed only in the hypotheses recalled in art. 10 of the Fees Regulations.

Exempted from registration fee, contributions, regional tax for studies and supplementary accident insurance

Students enrolled in Medical Area Specialization Schools:

Exempted from the regional tax for studies

Medicine and surgery graduates, enrolled in EEC regulated Medical Area Specialization Schools:

Exempted from the supplementary accident insurance

Students enrolled in the Law Specialization School, who qualify for or receive the regional grants distributed by EdISU¹ :

The registration fee and the contributions will be refunded

The requirements to be admitted in the rankings are following:

- Students enrolled for the first time in the 1st year: they must have obtained a score of no less than 48/60 in the admission test
- Students enrolled in the 2nd year: they must have obtained an average score of at least 21/30 in the 1st year tests, including the final tests

Students enrolled in the Law Specialization School and in the PhD programmes, who qualify for but do not receive the regional grants distributed by EDISU

They will be reimbursed for the regional tax for studies (according to what specified in Art. 8 L.R. 13/12/2004 n. 33)

Students who qualify for and receive regional grants from the EDISU

They will be reimbursed or exempted for the students services fees

Students enrolled in the Specialization school for legal professions, who make an internship at the Courts of Pavia, according to a convention between the University of Pavia and the Courts of Pavia signed on 10/02/2016
